

US: FDA ramps up GMP inspections

The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has predicted that it will have completed about 250 Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) inspections in 2010, and plans to conduct double that number in 2011.

The 483 issues noted by FDA inspectors include:

- failure to conduct identity testing
- failure to have a manufacturing plan
- no quality assurance plans
- severe plant deficiencies.
