

GLOBAL GMP GUIDE PUBLISHED

The International Alliance of Dietary/Food Supplement Associations (IADSA) has released a Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) guide for supplements makers globally.

The guide covers quality management, premises and equipment, personnel and training, product and process development, manufacture, storage, transport and distribution.

Other topics covered include the recovery or re-working of materials, documentation, self-inspections, sub-contracting operations, laboratory testing, complaints procedures, product recall and emergency procedures.

"It is written in such a way that it provides advice on all aspects of GMP in a non-prescriptive framework format, which allows for flexibility in application within any region," said Sam Jennings, coordinator of IADSA's GMP Working Group.
